Please read and initial to indicate understanding of the following rules and regulations:

1. _____ The Holloman Youth Programs Enhanced Power Hour Tutoring Program is free to all children who are already enrolled in the Holloman School Age Center and the Holloman Youth and Teen Center's open recreation program. If your child is not a member of the School Age Center or the Youth and Teen Center, you may register at the front desk of building 647.
2. _____ Children 9 years of age and older are eligible for the Youth and Teen Center's open recreation program. To become a member of the Youth and Teen Center, an additional registration packet is required and the cost of an annual membership is

\$48.00. If your child is 8 years of age or younger, they are not eligible for the Youth and Teen Center's open recreation program. However, to participate in the Enhanced Power Hour you can turn in this packet and pay a one-time fee of \$48.00 to gain access. While this fee will not make your child eligible for open recreation, you will still receive membership status which will provide you access to a discounted rate for all sports and other recreational activities that Youth Programs provides to your child's age range for one calendar year from the date of payment.

3. _____ All children participating in the Enhanced Power Hour Program must have a valid flu shot on file with the front desk prior to starting the tutoring program. This is an Air Force policy and applies to children enrolled in the School Age Center, the Youth and Teen Center, and children who have paid the \$48.00 fee to participate in Enhanced Power Hour. (Flu shots are valid for one calendar year from the date they are administered.)

4. _____ Tutoring sessions will be held Monday through Friday and all sessions are one hour each. Sessions will begin each day at 2:00pm and run hourly until the last session which begins at 6:00pm. The Youth Center will close at 7:00pm.

5. _____ There is a limit of two sign ups per week per child. The two sign up spots are not allowed to run consecutively (i.e. Monday at 2:00 to 3:00 and Monday 3:00 to 4:00). Sign ups are available one calendar month at a time. You may select two sessions per week per child for the entire month, however you may not reserve spots for the following month until at least the first business day of that month.

6. _____ Walk-ins are not allowed.

7. _____ Cancellations must be made 24-hours in advance. If for any reason you are unable to attend your tutoring session and a 24-hour notice cannot be given, please call the front desk at 575-572-3753 so that we may notify the tutor.

8. _____ For safety purposes, children under 9 years old must be supervised by their parent(s) at all times while attending the Enhanced Power Hour.

9. _____ For health and safety purposes, no outside food or drink is allowed inside the Youth and Teen Center. Water is allowed, as long as it is in a clear container.

10. _____ Please make sure that your child brings their laptop/Chromebook, log-in information, and any other materials they may need to participate in the Enhanced Power Hour.
